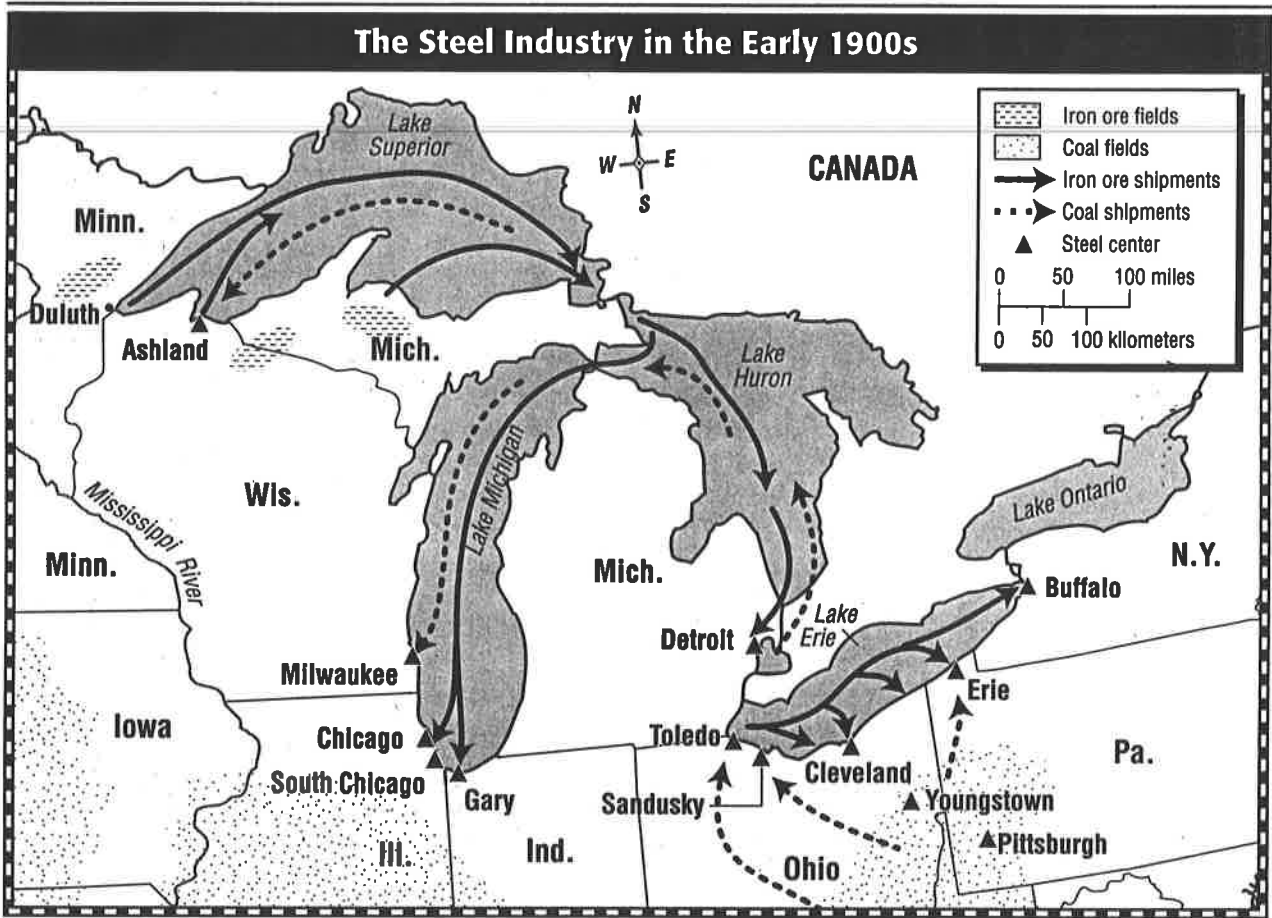

2. Identify which states produced coal used to make steel. Color these states yellow and label each with the letter "C" for coal.
3. **Region** Identify the two areas where steel was made. Draw a circle around each area and write "steel" in each circle.
4. Use blue to color the bodies of water used to ship both iron and coal. Label each with the letter "T" for transportation.
5. Explain why steel industries were located near the Great Lakes and close to areas that supplied coal. _____
