

- **2.** Identify which states produced coal used to make steel. Color these states yellow and label each with the letter "C" for coal.
- **3. Region** Identify the two areas where steel was made. Draw a circle around each area and write "steel" in each circle.
- **4.** Use blue to color the bodies of water used to ship both iron and coal. Label each with the letter "T" for transportation.
- **5.** Explain why steel industries were located near the Great Lakes and close to areas that supplied coal.
