Guidelines For the Revolutionary Newspaper Project

1. Everyone needs to choose a role. The roles are:

<u>Editor:</u> Responsible for choosing the title and layout of your paper and for writing the editorial

<u>Illustrator</u>: Responsible for creating the political cartoon and drawing at least one other picture to go along with an article

Writer #1: Responsible for writing one article and the advertisement

Writer #2: Responsible for writing one article and the letter to the editor

Writer #3: Only if there are 5 people in your group – responsible for writing two items; your choice on whether they are articles, letters to the editor, or political cartoons

- 2. These things must be included in your newspaper: (Note: The page numbers refer to the <u>Creating America</u> textbook)
 - 2 news articles one about the Boston Massacre (p.165-166) and one about the Boston Tea Party (p.167)
 - 1 advertisement about the first meeting of the Continental Congress (p.171)
 - 1 editorial criticizing one of the acts discussed on pages 159-171 in your textbook
 - 1 political cartoon criticizing one of the acts discussed on pages 159-171 in your textbook
 - 1 letter to the editor written from the British perspective, supporting or defending an act discussed on pages 159-171 in your textbook
 - 1 picture to illustrate one of the articles
 - 1 staff info box with group members' names and roles
- 3. In order to get a high grade, you must include all of the items listed above, work cooperatively with your group, and demonstrate that you understand both the content of the British acts and the colonial reaction to them.
